



Over the next century, the Metro Mayors region is projected to experience up to 1 meter of sea level rise, which will create significant additional threats from coastal flooding and storms. Climate change will increase coastal communities' vulnerability to flooding because higher sea levels will allow waves and storm surge to reach further inland than in the past.

This map highlights areas that are particularly at risk to coastal flooding considering current flood risk, future sea level rise projections, and recurring loss data.

This map highlights areas that may be at risk due to flooding from coastal storm events and sea level rise and was created by combining the following criteria:
